

Please note that the list of bills below includes the bills that have seen some movement during the 2018 Session such as being referred to a Committee or assigned a new subcommittee. It is not an exhaustive list of all bills still eligible for consideration that are of interest to IEC. Any bills that were still “alive” at the end of the 2018 Legislative Session are still eligible for consideration now, including Ways and Means and Appropriations bills.

SF 388	State Gov't Committee	Allows local jurisdictions to meet minimum state requirements with the 2009 energy building code. HF 484/ SF 456	Ag Committee	Dissolves the boards of the Des Moines, West Des Moines, and Urbandale waterworks and transfers control of water operations and facilities to the cities. Prohibits these cities from planning or beginning construction on new water plants before January 1, 2018. <i>House bill assigned to House Ag Committee. Senate bill assigned to Senate Ag Subcommittee of Zumbach, Rozenboom, and Kinney.</i>	Against

HF 2017	Jones	Eliminates the Iowa Department of Public Health and transfers duties to the Iowa Department of Human Services and Department of Public Safety. <i>Referred to State Government subcommittee of Highfill, Koester, and R. Smith.</i>	Against
SF 2069	Sinclair, Rozenboom, Brown, Shipley, Schultz, Edler, Chelgren, Zumbach, Segebarts, and Costello.	Property tax exemption for forest and fruit tree reservations. <i>Referred to Ways and Means Committee.</i>	Undecided
