(Formerly HSB 80). <i>Passed the Environmental Protection Committee 21-0. Referred to Ways &amp; Means Committee and recommended for passage.</i>	Monitoring / Undecided

Boulton, Segebart	DNR Commercial Fishing – An act relating to commercial fishing to remove underused, undesirable, and injurious organisms from waters of the state, and including applicability provisions. (Formerly HF 318) <i>Passed Natural Resources Committee 20-0. Passed House 99-0. Natural Resources and Environment Committee recommends passage 13-0, amendment filed. Placed on unfinished business calendar.</i>	Monitoring/ Undecided
<a href="#">HF 677 / HSB 81</a>	Shipley, Anderson, T. Moore	DNR Matters - Establishes a 60-day period for certain appeals to orders from the DNR. Allows the DNR to exempt a class of waste disposal systems if the class does not discharge into the waters of the state and is currently exempt. Strikes certain newspaper publication requirements for notice on permits for community public water systems. <i>Passed the Environmental Protection Committee 19-0. Placed on</i>	Monitoring / Undecided

<a href="#">SF 203</a>	Chapman	Private Fishing and Stocking Private Waters – allows a person to fish on a private lake or pond without a license. The person must first obtain the consent of the owner of lessee of the lake or pond before fishing. Prohibits the NRC from stocking a private lake or pond. Allows the NRC to stock a creek or stream flowing through private property. (Formerly SF 46) <i>Passed the Senate Natural Resources and Environment Committee 12-0. Passed Senate 34-14. House subcommittee passed with a 2-1 vote with an amendment that strikes the bill's allowance to fish on a private pond without a fishing license. Passed House Natural Resources with an amendment will go back to Senate for concurrence. Placed on unfinished business calendar.</i>	Monitoring / Undecided
<a href="#">SF 229</a>	Chapman	Leasing/Selling Water Systems - Allows the sale or lease of water systems if claims about the removal of health-related contaminants are certified by a national organization. Eliminates the requirement that the consumer be given certain information from the DPH. (Formerly SF 25). <i>Passed Commerce Committee 15-0. Placed on Unfinished Business Calendar.</i>	Monitoring / Undecided
<a href="#">HF 464</a>	Bossmann, Windschitl, Hein, Jacoby	Recreation Savings Accounts – Establishes Recreation Savings Account. Allows persons to establish a recreation savings account for a beneficiary for qualified recreation costs. Allows donations up to \$2,000 annually to be excluded from income. Requires withdrawn funds used for non-qualifying purposes to be added back into income. Includes implementing provisions. <i>Referred to Ways &amp; Means.</i>	Monitoring / Undecided
